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## ELKHART COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SPILL CONTROL PACKET

This packet is provided as a public service by the Environmental Health Services Division of the Elkhart County Health Department. This information is deemed reliable, but may not cover all legal aspects related to a discharge or spill. Its sole intent is to provide you with the basis for proper response to a discharge or spill.

Any discharge or spill of toxic or hazardous materials as defined by Section 3, Item HH of the Elkhart County Groundwater Protection Ordinance must be reported to Environmental Health Services. Section 3, Item HH defines the term “toxic or hazardous substance” as any substance defined in Section 102 of CERCLA including petroleum, crude oil or any fraction thereof, which is liquid at standard conditions of temperature and pressure (60) degrees Fahrenheit and 14.7 pounds per square inch absolute), or radioactive and infectious substances as defined by any applicable local, state or federal law or regulation.

The potentially responsible party or facility shall notify Environmental Health Services within 24 hours of discovery of any discharge in Elkhart County. Initial notification may be made by calling the Environmental Health Services Division at **574-875-3391** or dialing **911**. The potentially responsible party shall contain the spill, if possible and undertake activities needed to accomplish a spill response or clean up. A completed report detailing the discharge, how it occurred, what was discharged, when it occurred, where it was discharged, what corrective actions were taken and any other pertinent information must be submitted to Environmental Health Services **within ten (10) working days** using the **enclosed form**. These items are covered in Section 10 of the Groundwater Protection Ordinance.

Failure to comply with Section 10 of the Elkhart County Groundwater Protection Ordinance constitutes a violation of the ordinance. Violations may be cause for penalties to be levied against the potentially responsible party or facility of up to \$2,500.00 for each and every violation. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed to constitute a separate violation. A copy of the ordinance is available through the Elkhart County Health Department.
